Erasmus Students must send within the deadline (see above):

- Application form (with two passport-size photos) - Transcript of records

- Learning agreement

- Copy of a valid ID or passport - Accommodation form (if relevant)

All Non-European students must be provided of VISA.

In order to apply for it, they may ask for an official invitation letter to be submitted along the other documents to Italian embassy.
