Insurance	Exchange students are personally responsible for the insurances for themselves and their personal belongings.
	The insurance should be obtained before arrival to Finland, and it should cover costs resulting from illness or an accident (doctor and hospital charges, including medical treatment and hospitalisation, medication, and costs resulting from interruption of the exchange).
