<p>Language requirements</p>	<p>We do NOT require any official certificates. But we do expect Erasmus students to be sufficiently proficient in German in order to be able to successfully cope with academic work (language level B2), due to the fact that the majority of courses and lectures in Heidelberg are taught in German. Other language requirements: For example English language skills required for the Master “Molecular Biosciences“; Japanese language skills for the Master of “Japanese Studies”.</p>
<p>Language Courses:</p>	<p>In order to help with adjusting to life at a German university and to brush up on language skills, Erasmus students may take part in an intensive four-week language course before the semester begins as well as weekly courses during the semester.</p>
