NEW: Academic Calendar 2011-2012:

Orientation Session: the week before the beginning of the term

Autumn term: 19 September 2011 – 17 February 2012 (end of exams) Spring term: 20 February 2012 – 22 June 2012 (end of exams)

NEW: Admission and Registration Procedure for 2011-2012:

Follow the instructions to **register online** on our website: http://www.unige.ch/erasmus
A letter of acceptance and other information will be sent directly to the students in June 2011 at the latest

Deadline for registration (Autumn and Spring terms): 15 May 2011

Late registrations will be accepted until 30 November 2011 for the spring semester, but with no quarantee of scholarship or assistance from the accommodation office.

Academic Preparation:

Before coming to Geneva, students should select the courses they wish to attend using the course catalogue: http://www.unige.ch/progcours.html or the website of the faculty/department. They must send their study programme to the academic coordinator of the agreement in Geneva in order to validate it, especially if they plan to take courses at master level.

Residence Permit / Visa:

A residence permit is needed for EU citizens if the stay in Geneva is longer than 3 months. Information about the residence permit will be given during the Orientation Session. Non-EU citizens must contact the nearest Swiss embassy 3 months before entering Switzerland in order to inquire about the visa procedure.

Health Insurance:

Health insurance is mandatory in Switzerland. Students from an EU-member state should bring an appropriate insurance certificate (e.g. European Health Insurance card or certificate completed by their private insurance company).

Accommodation:

It is difficult to find accommodation in Geneva. In order to be on a waiting list for a room in a University residence, the accommodation application form should be returned before **15 June** to the "Bureau du logement". Exchange students are advised to contact our accommodation office: http://www.unige.ch/dase/bulog/ in order to have access to a list of rooms to rent.

Language course:

Erasmus students can attend a free French course. The course starts after the beginning of the semester (more information during the orientation Session). There is also a fee-paying course in summer, during the holidays (see http://www.unige.ch/lettres/elcf/coursete/)

NEW:Scholarship:

From 2011-2012, Switzerland will join the official LLP/ERASMUS programme of the European Union, and the Swiss Erasmus scholarship will no longer be paid to incoming students. Erasmus scholarships will then have to be paid by the sending institution.
