The Danish Coordinated Admission (KOT) – purpose and facs

- The main purpose of KOT is to coordinate the admission to higher education to make sure, that any applicant can apply for admission to up to 8 programmes, but will receive only one offer for a study place - at the highest possible priority.
- More than 90.0000 applicants with 250.000 applications to 880 programmes at 34 higher educational institutions

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
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The application portal: Optagelse.dk

- Common application deadline
- Applying with a Danish digital signature is mandatory (for Danes)
- Digital diplomas from Danish upper secondary education
- Joint effort to detect cheaters trying to apply with false diplomas

Assessment of the applications

Assessment of applications is done at the educational institutions



The Coordinated Admission - distribution of study places

- The IT-system of the Coordinated Admission distribute the study places based on:
 - The assesments from the educational institutions
 - The number of study places and quota allocation
 - The apllicant's priority lists from the admission portal

Welcome to the joint application portal for master's programmes, electives, continuing and further education and training at the Danish universities.

Select how you want to log in:

In order to use the portal you must log in using one of the following:

- . If you already have a login at a Danish University, select 'Log in', after which you must select your University in WAYF-list.
- If you have previously created a user account for this portal, select 'Log in as self-registered user'.
- If you want to log in using NemID, select 'Log in with NemID'.

Important! Remember to use the same login in the future, so that you can find your applications again as they are identified by the email address, that is transferred with your 'Log in' information.

If you don't have NemID or a login at a Danish University, you must first register as a user here.



DANS - A few facts

- Handles all other applications at the universities than ordinary bachelorapplications
- Webservices connecting STADS and DANS
- 100.000 applications pr. year (approx. 35.000 applicants)
- Centrally driven one database, but universities can not see each others data
- No national clearing/coordination
